#### Kinder Orientation

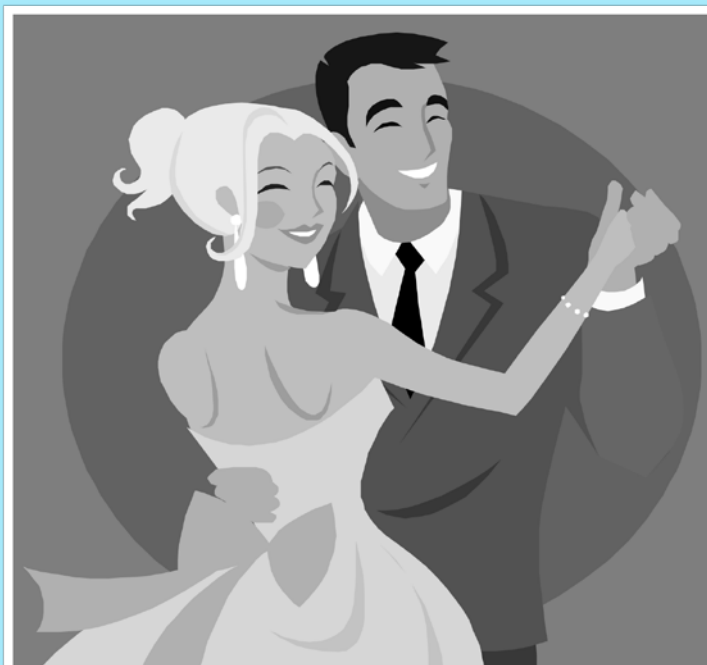

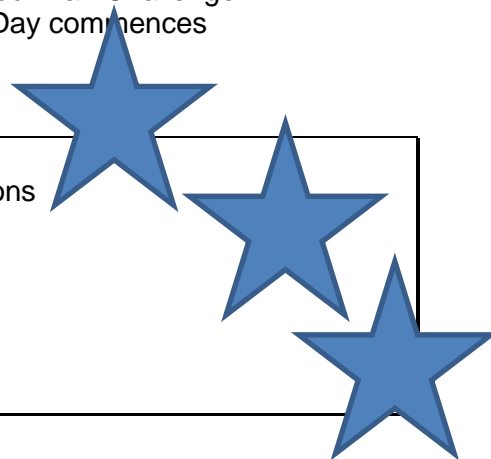
