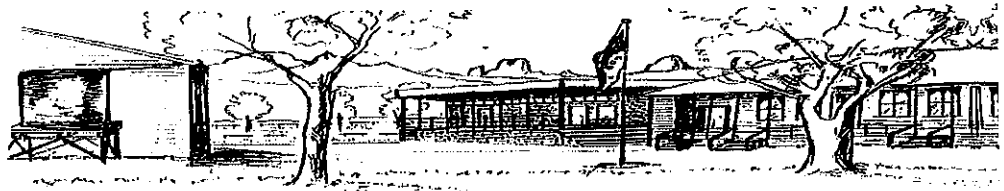

- Evening performance Wednesday 5th December – 7pm.

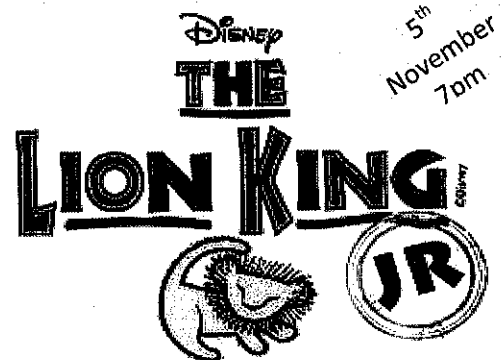
Kookaburra March

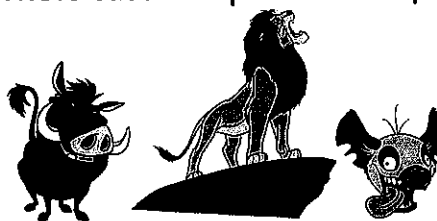
Farrer Memorial Agricultural High School - Tamworth
