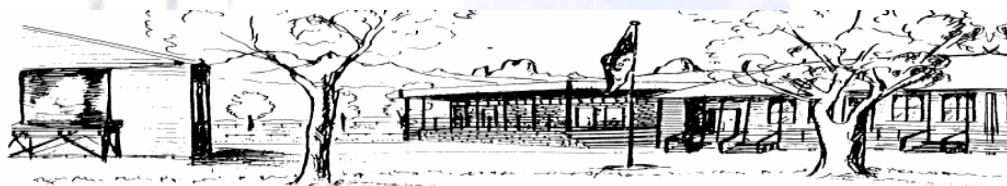

8. Enter your payment details and hit **PAY**. A \$1handling fee is applicable to this service. Mastercard & VISA

9. A receipt for payment and order will be sent to the email address provided.

10. Your package will be dispatched to your school approximately 25working days after final photographs are taken.
