#### Life Education Van

All students participated in programs on Tuesday. K/1, 2/3 and 4/5/6 had different topics.

**K/1-** "Harold's Mystery Tour" - identifying the function of vital organs, recognizing that a balanced diet and exercise promotes good health, exploring strategies to manage feelings and emotions, safety in public places and recognizing the safe use and storage of medicines.

**2/3-** "All Systems Go" – factors that influence the function of body systems, exploring ways to manage peer pressure, the effects of second hand smoke, the function of vital organs (heart, lungs, brain and kidneys), healthy food choices.

**4/5/6-** "On The Case" – what's in a cigarette, effects of smoking, history and laws, myths and facts, influences and pressures and strategies to reduce harm.
