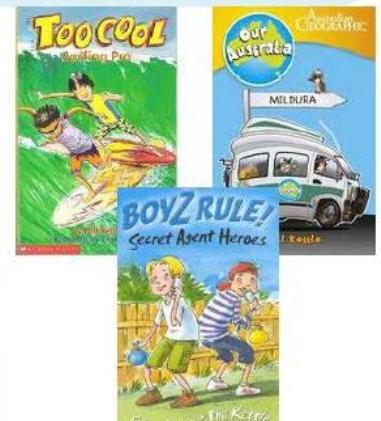
Cricket Skills Day – Eumungerie 13th March
