Tooraweenah Public School would like to thank the parents and community for their strong support in helping us collect Earn and Learn stickers from Woolworths. This year we collected an incredible 10,094 stickers which qualified us for \$600 in school resources from Modern Teaching Aids. External Validation Meeting

Our External Validation Meeting was held yesterday. Mrs Jenkin and I met with the panel and discussed our on balance judgements when completing the School Evaluation Framework Self Assessment Survey and the evidence to support it. The process allowed the school to reflect on our progress towards goals and our overall delivery in 14 aspects of the school including teaching, learning and leadership. The panel agreed with our self-assessment in 11 areas of the framework, and suggested our evidence placed us higher than we thought, at sustaining and growing for three more areas.

Thank you to parents Jamee Wykes, Gavin Duff and Craig Smith for providing transport and accompanying staff on this excursion.

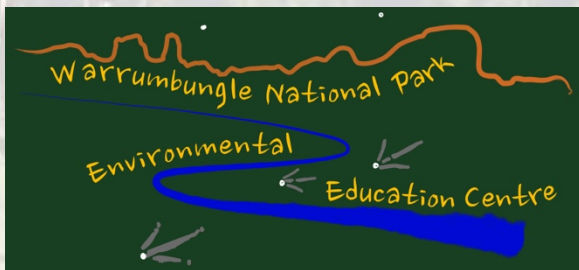
John Fleming Visit- please note change

Students are not permitted to bring noodles that require boiling water for school lunches. This is due to student safety. Thank you for your support with this matter.

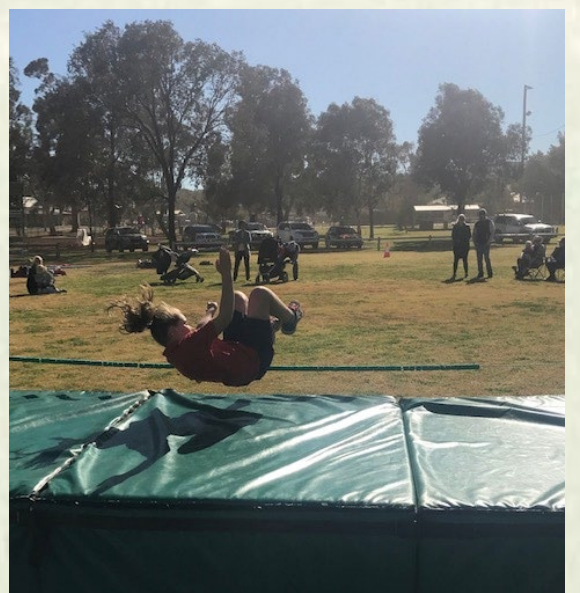
