The school has sky blue polo shirts \$20, sports shirts \$30, hats \$14, jumpers \$25 in stock.

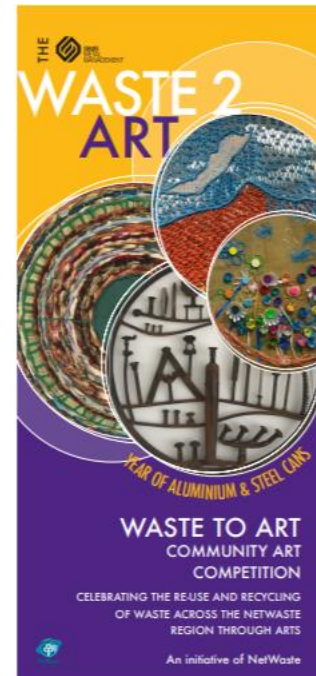
School dresses, check shorts, and winter long sleeve blue shirts may also be ordered.

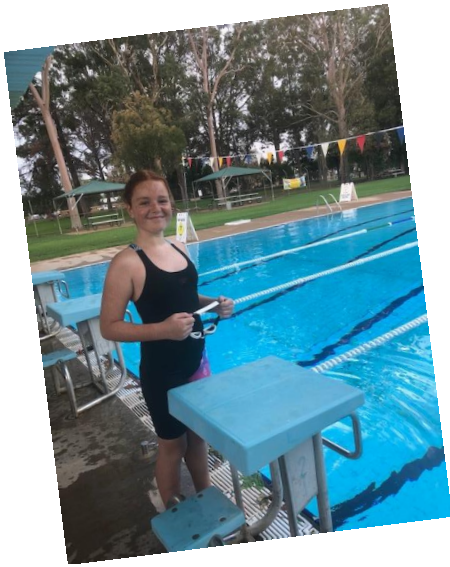
