Combined Network Conference

Last Thursday and Friday, Mrs Smith attended the Combined Network Principal's Conference which involved the Western Plains network alongside 4 other networks Peel, Mooki, Barwon and Namoi. The two days saw training delivered in explicit teaching, Principal wellbeing, school promotion, and work, health & safety. There were also workshops based on anti-racism, writing guides and invaluable hands-on learning.

The Rural Regional and Remote team who attended the conference, confirmed information that may impact school bus runs as outlined below.

<u>School Bus</u>

School bus services across NSW are currently undergoing regular monitoring of student numbers and now with assisted technology evident on bus services including counters at the door and CC TV, more accurate data is being provided to Transport NSW on actual numbers using school bus services. **With this in mind, I would like to encourage families to consider using buses more regularly wherever possible.** School bus runs with numbers under 8 students per trip are open to being monitored for viability. Student numbers registered on the run are no longer being used to determine viability, but rather, numbers of students actually using the run.
