Gilgandra Excursion

It was a great opportunity to visit some of our local attractions as part of our history units *Past, Present and Future* (K/l) and *Then and Now* (2/3/5). Students attended the Gilgandra Museum, Coo-ee Heritage Centre, Hunter Park and even had a chance to call into the Gilgandra Regional Library.



At the Gilgandra Museum, students were amazed to see rooms set up like they would have been in the past including the Uargon Subsidised School (1928-1945), complete with school desks, blackboard, and cane; a hospital room; a kitchen with meat safe, arger wood fire for cooking; blacksmith's shop; and the old Tooraweenah Gaol. With so many items in the museum of local significance to our families it was a special visit indeed. The farm machinery was also very popular with the students. Many comparisons were made from the old to the new.

The Coo-ee Heritage Centre exhibits were well received, as were the vast collection of fossils and shells.

After a break at Hunter Park, students were treated to a talk and tour of the Gilgandra Library by Librarian Christina Wendt. Ms Wendt outlined the many activities, resources in the library, including Lego Club, school holiday activities, and borrowing books, audio books, games and puzzles. ANZAC Day






