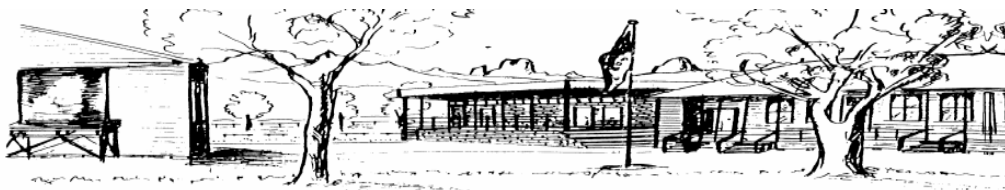

Excursion to Eumungerie

On Monday, Year 6 participated in an informative Personal Development Program delivered by the Western NSW Local Health District Women's Health Service at Eumungerie Public School. Four small schools participated: Tooraweenah, Eumungerie, Geurie and Wongarbon. This program was designed to help both boys and girls navigate the physical and emotional changes they experience during puberty, reinforcing that these changes are a normal part of growth and development. The program provided a safe and supportive environment for students to ask questions and engage in meaningful discussions about their development.

Additionally, our Year 3/4 students had the opportunity to travel to Eumungerie Public School for a Technology Sharing day. They joined the K-4 class to share their experiences coding with Lego Spike Essential. The day was filled with collaborative learning as students engaged in various classroom sessions, exchanging knowledge and skills in technology.

Both events proved to be valuable experiences for our students, fostering personal growth and encouraging teamwork and collaboration.
