<u>Happy Holidays</u>



Public visitors are *not required* to check-in or be screened.

This Includes:

- pick up/drop off
- attending parent teacher nights
- attending school fetes or activities open to the public
- spectator at school sport activities
- watching presentations and performances.

Parent and carer volunteers need a declaration (no WWCC) and are required to check-in. This includes when volunteering on school canteen.




